I would like to invite you to take part in our Matariki – in pursuit of the Stars 2020 exhibition running for four weeks in July 2020 in conjunction with the Auckland Matariki Festival. The Exhibition will be held in the Education Wing Foyer Gallery at the Estuary Arts Centre in Orewa.

The exhibition is open to all artists who work in any medium. Artist may submit a body of work which could comprise a group of pieces which make one work, a series of work or a singular work. There are no size restrictions, but the work must meet the brief of Matariki – In pursuit of the Stars.

The exhibition will be a selected show and will be curated by Kim Boyd. All artists will have at least one work/group/series accepted and shown in the exhibition.
