<b><u>Stall holder's take down</u></b>	from 4pm (you cannot leave the event earlier than this)

- **Cost for art and craft stalls:** \$30 single (3x3) (no commission)  
\$60 (6x3) (no commission)
- **Cost for food stalls:** \$60 for a single stall (3x3) or one vehicle (10% commission applicable)  
\$120 for a double stall (6x3) or Truck (10% commission applicable)

- Stall holders must provide their own methods to take payments ie: cash float, eft facilities. EAC will not hold any cash on site.
- Stall holders are responsible for their own insurance.

- All packaging must be either bio-degradable or recyclable, this means no plastic bags or polystyrene containers etc.
- All food stalls must display or have available evidence of compliance with local food regulations i.e. Food Premises Licence.
